School's Back in Session with FREE Meals for All In School and Remote Learning Students!

Free Meals include both Breakfast and Lunch!
(available for entire school year)

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced that schools may extend the free meals program that our district participated in from March until June. This announcement means that all students enrolled in Portsmouth schools will receive **FREE** meals regardless of eligibility status beginning Monday, September 14. This includes meals for students who are enrolled in our optional remote learning model or are eating in school. Per the USDA, this program will now be available through June 30, 2021.

Please note we are only able to provide free meals to children 18 and under and will only be provided as a complete meal per program guidelines. All extra items, including milk to accompany a lunch brought from home or ala carte, *are not* included in this program. Students must have sufficient funds available in their food service accounts in order to purchase extra items. A la carte milk is \$.55.
